

1. A duly advertised regular session of the Board of Education was called to order by President Kathy Mott at 7:30 p.m. in the North Harrison Middle School Library.
2. Secretary Ron Coleman polled the Board and found that all members were present.
3. Mr. Ron Coleman moved and Mr. Robert Chinn seconded a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
4. Mrs. Leslie Robertson moved and Mr. Fred Naegele seconded a motion to approve merchant claims #692 thru #899 and the payroll for May 16 and May 30, 2003. The motion passed with a unanimous vote. (Claim #692 was approved for payment at the April 10, 2003 meeting but was included in the May 8, 2003 claim docket signed by the board.)
5. Mr. Fred Naegele moved and Mr. Ron Coleman seconded a motion to accept the resignations of North Harrison High School English teacher Mrs. Jill Robertson effective at the end of the 2002-2003 school year and NHCSC Operations Supervisor Mr. John McClanahan (retirement) effective September 26, 2003. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
6. Mrs. Leslie Robertson moved and Mr. Ron Coleman seconded a motion to approve the following appointments: Mr. Bart Bigham as an English teacher at North Harrison High School beginning with the 2003-2004 school year; Mrs. Kimberly Allen as a business teacher at North Harrison High School beginning with the 2003-2004 school year; and Tina Purcell as a teacher (temporary contract) at North Harrison Middle School from April 14, 2003 thru the rest of the 2002-2003 school year. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
7. Mrs. Fred Naegele moved and Mr. Robert Chinn seconded a motion to approve the textbook published by Harcourt as the fourth grade social studies textbook for 2003-2009. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
8. Mrs. Leslie Robertson moved and Mr. Ron Coleman seconded a motion to appoint Mrs. Linda Schneider as North Harrison's representative to the Harrison County Library Board. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
9. Mr. Robert Chinn moved and Mr. Fred Naegele seconded a motion to accept a donation of \$675.00 from First Harrison Bank to Morgan Elementary School for a trip to Conner Prairie. There was no matching requirement. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
10. Mr. Fred Naegele moved and Mrs. Leslie Robertson seconded a motion to authorize the administration to advertise for bids on a variety of goods and services needed during the coming school year (fuel, cafeteria items, etc.). The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
11. Mr. Robert Chinn moved and Mr. Fred Naegele seconded a motion to approve signing a right-of-entry with the Indiana Department of Transportation for improvements to be made near both entrances to the North Harrison Complex at Ramsey. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
12. Mrs. Leslie Robertson moved and Mr. Ron Coleman seconded a motion to approve June 7, 2003 at 9:00 a.m. at the Hampton Inn in Corydon as the date, time and place for a special board meeting for a board/superintendent retreat and the yearly evaluation of the Superintendent. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
13. Mrs. Leslie Robertson moved and Mr. Fred Naegele seconded a motion to conduct summer school in a similar manner to previous summer schools. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

14. Superintendent Monty Schneider informed the board on the refunding of the high school bonds, temporary loan, alternative school and the corporation newsletter.
15. Mr. Greg Rupp asked if the newsletter could be distributed to schools for those staff members who live outside the school corporation.
16. Principal Lance Richards of Morgan Elementary School talked about the upcoming fourth grade visit to the upper elementary school, the accelerated reading program, the Morgan 500 and thanked the Board for summer school.
17. Principal Sharon Uhl of North Harrison Upper Elementary School spoke about the fourth grade visits, sixth grade camping trip, the field days and thanked the Board for summer school.
18. Principal Sheryl Burns of North Harrison Elementary School thanked the Board for summer school and also spoke about Young Authors, the Book Fair, Louisville "Bats" field trip, Kosair Hospital donation, and the cookout for the elementary staff.
19. Principal Jon Howerton of North Harrison Middle School informed the Board about the eighth grade trip to Indianapolis, the choir and band concerts and eighth grade graduation.
20. Principal Kelly Simpson of North Harrison High School talked about the prom, first scheduled baseball game on new field, academic banquet and other end of year activities including graduation.
21. Mr. Fred Naegele congratulated the senior class and wished the staff a good vacation.
22. Mrs. Leslie Robertson congratulated the seniors on their accomplishments.
23. Mr. Robert Chinn thanked the seniors for coming to the meeting and that his first year on the board had been fun.
24. Mr. Ron Coleman congratulated the seniors and wished them well.
25. Mrs. Kathy Mott congratulated the seniors and said that the Renaissance pamphlet and the corporation newsletter looked good and that the sixth grade camping trip was very worthwhile.
