

1. A duly advertised special meeting of the Board of Education was called to order by President Buddy Bosler at 8:00 p.m. in the North Harrison Middle School Library.
2. Secretary Robert Chinn polled the Board and found that all members were present.
3. Mr. Fred Naegele moved and Mr. Ron Coleman seconded a motion to approve the resignation of Anna Snider as seventh grade girl's basketball coach (lay) at North Harrison Middle School. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
4. Mr. Robert Chinn moved and Mr. Gary Byrne seconded a motion to approve the appointments of Karen Lambertus as a principal (2 year contract) at North Harrison Middle School beginning 2007-08 school year; Meghan Churchill Crosier as an elementary teacher April 2, 2007 to May 24, 2007 (temporary contract) at North Harrison Elementary School; Evalina Pinnick as co-varsity cheer coach at North Harrison High School; Patricia Capehart as an elementary teacher at North Harrison Elementary School beginning 2007-08 school year; Angelica DeGrasse as a Spanish teacher at North Harrison High School beginning the 2007-08 school year. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
5. Mr. Fred Naegele moved and Mr. Robert Chinn seconded a motion to approve the advertisement for 19 contracted bus routes beginning with the 2007-2008 school year. The motion passed with a 4-0-1 vote (with Mr. Bosler abstaining).
6. Mr. Gary Byrne moved and Mr. Ron Coleman seconded a motion to approve the adoption of textbooks for the 2007-08 school year. Textbooks selected in Reading were Scott Foresman (grades 1-5) and Prentice Hall (grades 6-8). A waiver for the use of no textbook was selected in Handwriting (grades 1-3). The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
7. Superintendent Monty Schneider updated the community concerning the May 15, 2007 executive session to review superintendent applications.
8. Superintendent Monty Schneider updated the Board on the next Bargaining Session scheduled for May 2, 2007.
9. Superintendent Monty Schneider stated that the next Board meeting will be May 10, 2007.
10. Mr. Robert Chinn moved and Mr. Ron Coleman seconded a motion to adjourn the Board meeting. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
11. The meeting adjourned at 8:18 p.m.
12. At 8:29 p.m., the Board met in executive session with members all members present. Also present were Monty Schneider, Ken Oppel, Kelly Simpson and Lance Richards. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information regarding employees, prospective employees, collective bargaining and pending litigation. The executive session ended at 10:27 p.m. with no action being taken.
