Motion passed 3-2 with Mr. Bobby Chinn and Mr. Fred Naegele voting against.
20. Mr. Jerry Renneker moved and Mr. Fred Naegele seconded motion to approve permission to apply for a grant from The Harrison County Community Foundation for \$7,260.00 to fund the Random Drug Testing Program for the High School. (No match required) Motion passed 5-0.
21. Mr. Michael Beyerle moved and Mr. Fred Naegele seconded motion to approve permission to apply for a grant from The Harrison County Community Foundation for \$4,065.00 to develop an intervention program for students who have either tested positive or have been involved with illegal drugs and or alcohol. (No match required) Motion passed 5-0.
