Since the state legislature enacted legislation which requires all board elections to take place, now, in November, North Harrison must change from school board elections during the May primary to the November election. I recommend that the individuals serve in the nominated positions that we'll be nominating soon for the officers. newly elected board members will be -- well, actually the positions would start July 2011 and run through January 2013. So actually instead of one year, the reorganization would be for an 18month period. Also it means that the elected board members before us will have their elected

terms to increase by 6 months. And that's something that was brought on by legislature and 2 3 we're just going to -- Tonight I would like to see that, that if the board is willing, we -- as 4 long as it's reflected in board minutes we're .5 permitted to, instead of reorganizing again next 6 summer, we're permitted to allow the 7 reorganization to take place and cover the 18 8 month period. That would be my preference. It 9 seems reasonable. After conferring with Indiana 10 School Board Association they concur that if the 11 board approves and the minutes show that then we 12 13 will allow for the board members that are elected in these official positions to have a term of 18 14 months. 15 16

We had huge improvements at North Harrison Elementary, the middle school, the high school and also had improvement at Morgan, who were -- they were already exemplary as far as their scores at Morgan. They just needed to maintain and improve and they did that. North Harrison led all of the seven area school corporations in every category reported. The three categories were --

-- the first was a percentage of students passing
both English and math. Also students passing
separately language arts and also students passing
math separately. So all three categories we were

at the tops of the list for the whole area. We've already had a congratulations but I would further say that our students, parents, staffs and administrators deserve a round of applause again.

And from my standpoint I said -- I suggest a standing ovation for such an excellent performance.

MR. ROEDER: Yes, I'll comment on that. Anyone that's familiar with the system in depth knows that the last couple of years when we've had teachers retire through attrition we've had to not replace, which has caused class sizes to go up somewhat. And I'll have comments regarding proposed projected budget later on in the meeting but we have discussed these issues with the board. We got a lot of discussion. Programming impacts are tough just the same as class size increases are tough. In the case of impacting there will be a reduced amount of art at North Harrison Elementary, a little bit. There will be some impact there. I'd say a greater impact and probably an issue at the middle school since it will be not a full-time position. But those were debated and it's my recommendation to not only do

25

that but we'll be taking a recommendation for additional looks at personnel much further as we get into next spring. And I'll kinda lay that out in detail a little bit at the end of the meeting. But we have to tighten our belts in every way possible and every time a position comes open it's scrutinized as to whether or not we would replace, if we would replace, replace at a part- or full-That's just what we're gonna -- That's the environment we're gonna be in for the next 2 or 3 years at least until we get some student enrollment increases and hopefully more money from the state, which is really what makes the difference. But -- And there are some other factors, which I'll get into more detail later on in the comments about our budget projections. But it's a reaction to the need to tighten our belts, the need to look seriously at every one of our hires coming in and what we're gonna do, whether we'll replace or not. And that would not just be teaching, that would also be non-certified too.

TAMMY SAGER: Okay. And on this particular hiring choices that you've made are all grades still covered in some form of art?

MR. ROEDER: They are, yes.

2	get?

24	huge increases in health insurance costs to the
25	school corporation, reduced state funding to North

Harrison as well as other school systems around the state, and a declining student enrollment in our schools over the past 6 years, which really further cuts the funding from the state to the school system, our budget projections do not look good. We have needed to take steps to not replace teachers retiring through attrition over the past couple of years as I mentioned previously. We also have had some increases in class sizes. But I'm afraid that that's only gonna get worse as we look into the next 2 to 3 years.

As a school system we need to tighten our belts further in every way possible over the next couple of years an even — with all of our best efforts to cut costs. We are facing a need for reduction in force, which will affect all areas of school personnel beginning with the 2012/13 school year as we will likely run out of money about the end of the 12/13 school year without severe cuts to all budgets and personnel.

As I indicated, it is important to put this out publicly. We need to brace for larger class sizes, possible reductions in programs. We've already seen some of that by some reduction with our art situation. We will have fewer resources

to keep our school system from going into a deficit position. We have publicly seen neighboring school systems cut personnel, programs, resources for students over the past couple of years and North Harrison is facing the same fate. Unsettling news but news that must be put out to the public as soon as we have a pretty good position and a pretty good projection in regard to that situation.

So that's the way it stands. That's something that we can continue to monitor but as early as possible that word needs to be put out to the public and also put out to the school community.

So I just wanted to add to what John said earlier. So thanks to

all of you for that.

Broughton. He is our new middle school English
Teacher. I've known Chris for a long time,
