

Attendance Policy

Regular attendance is necessary for a student to succeed in school. The North Harrison Community School Corporation firmly places the responsibility for regular school attendance on the student and his/her parent or legal guardian.

Students must be present to benefit from the concepts discussed in class and to carry out their responsibilities as students. When absenteeism noticeably affects a student's academic or personal success, or is in violation of the School Board Policy, the school shall take such action as deemed necessary to maintain good attendance. Your child should attend school consistently and should be absent only for illness or death in the immediate family. Please do not schedule extended family vacations during school time.

The adopted Morgan Elementary School policy states that students may have no more than (5) unexcused absences.

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to notify the school office of the reason for the absence, all absences not reported by parents are considered "unexcused absences." Only (5) parent "call in's" will be accepted. Once the (5) call in maximum has been reached, only a doctor's statement will be accepted to excuse an absence.

- Parents will be notified by email, when a student has accumulated five (5) unexcused absences.
- When a student has accumulated ten (10) unexcused absences during the school year, the Harrison County Prosecutors will be notified for habitual truancy.

The school reserves the right to determine if an absence is excused or unexcused
