

Important Info For Parents

- If your child is to ride the bus home with a friend, each child is to send a note to the teacher and one for the bus driver advising of such.
- School lunches are \$11.50 each week (\$2.30 per day) per child. Reduced lunches are \$2.00 each week per child.. If your student would like to purchase extras, available in the serving line, they will be charged for these items. Please make sure there are adequate funds in their account. You can send in cash or a check, payable to Morgan cafeteria, or you can pay by credit card or debit card in Harmony (This option includes a small fee.). If your child brings his/her lunch but would like to purchase milk or juice to go with that lunch, the cost will be 55¢.
- There will be a snack break each day. Students may buy juice or milk for 55¢. This fee does not come out of their lunch account. Students should bring change for the correct amount when purchasing.
- Anytime your child is to take ANY TYPE OF MEDICATION at school (including cough drops), you must submit the medication form (which is included on the website) that gives exact instructions on dosage and times medication is to be dispensed. This form must include your doctor's signature for both prescription and non-prescription drugs. You may also obtain a form by calling the school office.
- When paying lunch money, book rental, field trips, etc., please pay each with separate checks. Scholastic book orders (that the teachers send home with their students) should be made out directly to Scholastic.
- Returned Non Sufficient Funds check (NSF): Beginning with the 2010-2011 school year, a service charge of \$12.00 for checks that are returned to us by the bank. The person(s) writing the check will have 10 calendar days from notification to reimburse the school with cash for the amount of the check plus the \$12.00 service charge. Failure to reimburse within that ten day period will result in the NSF check being forwarded to the Harrison County Prosecutor's Office for collection.
- Students will NOT be allowed to pass out party invitations in the classroom, unless there is an invitation for EVERY STUDENT in the class. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.
- Students are NOT allowed to bring soft drinks to drink during their snack break or lunch break.
- If your child is a car rider in the mornings and plans on eating breakfast, they need to be dropped off by 8:00am. This will allow them to be in class at 8:15am and not marked tardy.
