

Important Info for Parents

- 1) If your child is to ride the bus home with a friend, each child is to send a note to the teacher and one for the bus driver advising of such.
- 2) School lunches are \$11.50 each week (\$2.30 per day) per child. Reduced lunches are \$2.00 each week per child. We ask that lunch money be paid on Mondays. If you would like, you can pay for your child's lunch by the month. All checks should be made payable to Morgan Elementary School. If your child brings his lunch but would like to purchase a milk to go with that lunch, the cost of that milk will be 55¢.
- 3) Breakfast will be \$1.60 per day. There will be no charge for breakfast for students that qualify for Free/Reduced lunches.
- 4) There will be a milk break each day. Students may buy juice or milk for 55¢. Students should bring change for the correct amount every day for milk break.
- 5) Anytime your child is to take ANY TYPE OF MEDICATION at school (including cough drops), you must submit the medication form (which is included on the website) that gives exact instructions on dosage and times medication is to be dispensed. This form must include your doctor's signature for both prescription and non-prescription drugs. You may also obtain a form by calling the school office.
- 6) When paying lunch money, book rental, field trips, etc. please pay each with separate checks. Scholastic book orders (that the teachers send home with their students) should be made out directly to Scholastic.
- 7) Returned Non Sufficient Funds check (NSF): Beginning with the 2010-2011 school year, a service charge of \$12.00 for checks that are returned to us by the bank. The person(s) writing the check will have 10 calendar days from notification to reimburse the school with cash for the amount of the check plus the \$12.00 service charge. Failure to reimburse within that ten day period will result in the NSF check being forwarded to the Harrison County Prosecutor's Office for collection.
- 8) Students will NOT be allowed to pass out party invitations in the classroom, unless there is an invitation for *EVERY STUDENT* in the class. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.
- 9) Students are NOT allowed to bring soft drinks to drink during their milk break or lunch break.
- 10) If your child is a car rider in the mornings and plans on eating breakfast, they need to be dropped off by 8:00am. This will allow them to be in class at 8:15 and not marked tardy.
